FOUR TRAILS FEASIBILITY STUDY

- Study for possible inclusion of a trail in an existing National Historic Trail (Trails Act 1968)
 - Oregon Trail
 - California Trail
 - Mormon Pioneer Trail
 - Pony Express Trail
- Process began in 1998
 - 77 study routes in 13 states
 - 12 in Washington and Oregon
 - 26 qualified

- Rationale from legislation

"To simplify future route markings and public information"

Those persons emigrating after 1848 (78% of total) are historically insignificant.

POSSIBLE ACTIONS

- Ask legislators to add Naches Pass Trail and other trails excluded under Criteria 11A.
- Ask NPS to re-evaluate trails with a more realistic Criteria 11A.
 - Would probably require recall of current document.
 - Modification of Trails Act?
- Form a new historic trail initiative (NPT alone).
